Star & Wreath Shaped Imperial Service Medals

All dates given refer to the date awards were gazetted in the London Gazette (LG)

The Edward VII medals appear to have been issued between May 1903 and April 1911. The George V medals were issued between July 1911 & Nov 1919, although it is possible that the first circular issue ISMs were also issued from Nov 1919

The Wreath shaped awards to women were first awarded in 1908; earlier awards were Stars

The Imperial Service Medal was originally issued unnamed. Medals issued after June 1908 were officially named (engraved in capitals) usually with the recipient's first name in full, then initials and surname (e.g. A RTHUR S. JONES)

The roll shows the following: Surname Forenames London Gazette Date Colony Notes

A tick in the Colony column denotes an award to a non UK civil servant

Any amendments to the LGs are show. The name is given in the corrected form with the earlier entry shown in colour. There was also one cancellation (recipient died before the award was gazetted).
